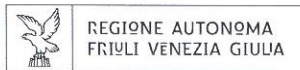

CFMUNESCO is the first Model United Nations UNESCO to take place in Europe and allows high school students from the age of 14 to 19 from all over the world to play the role of diplomats, simulating the United Nations' debates.

CFMUNESCO, which is organised by a group of students from Convitto Nazionale “Paolo Diacono”, consists in three days of intensive debates, from 26th to 28th of November, and simulates five committees: the Security Council, the Disarmament and International Security Committee, the United Nations Human Rights Council, the Environment Commission and the UNESCO. The latter was chosen as the special committee of our Conference in order to emphasize the link between the city of Cividale and the UN body, which classified Cividale del Friuli part of its World Heritage List in June 2011.

The Convitto is part of the UNESCO Associated Schools Project Network and the main theme of CFMUNESCO itself, To Protect and Preserve, is one of the main objectives of the United Nations and, particularly, of the UNESCO.
